



My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, dear Chapel community,

Please forgive me for dwelling longer on our recent chapel renovation. I still can't get over how beautiful our little chapel is and how brilliantly she shines, now that after 18 years, she's repainted, has new floors in the shop, confessional and office, her candle shrines scrubbed clean, and more. Since I came aboard here in June, I have been struck by people's appreciation for the chapel and their fiscal generosity for her. So many regulars and visitors share words of appreciation for Christ's and the OMV's presence here in the Marketplace. I frequently meet people in the shop, confessional or before and after Masses, who share richly of the blessing that this holy place is and has been to them. Stories that sometimes go back decades. Like the parents who visit from near and far who tell me they have brought their children here to see the place where they worshiped many years ago while here at University, or the folks who are in Boston for medical treatment, who come to rest in the presence of the Divine Physician exposed in the Blessed Sacrament. 

Jubilee 2025: Jubilee for Deacons February 21-23

Jubilee 2025 invites you to be a pilgrim of hope. For Christians, hope is anchored in the encounter with Jesus whose life, death, and resurrection reveals God's transforming love. Our hope in God is renewed constantly in the gift of the Holy Spirit, the love of the Father and the Son, who is given, even now, to the community of believers.

The deacon is obligated to give priority to the spiritual life and to live his diaconia with generosity. His model par excellence is Jesus Christ, the Servant who lived totally at the service of his Father for the good of every person. It is necessary that each deacon must know Christ intimately to live out his ministry to the fullest, whether he is celibate or married.



In his 2021 address to deacons, Pope Francis expressed a greater focus on cultivating humility and generosity in ministry. Speaking to them, the Holy Father says he expects humble deacons, letting all good be a secret between him and God; he expects deacons to be good spouses, fathers, and grandfathers, inspiring others with their witness of joy in everything without complaining; he expects deacons to be sentinels, to both know the face of the poor and also help the Christian faithful recognize Jesus in them.

The deacon exercises his ministry within the communion and mission of a diocesan Church and in direct relationship with his diocesan bishop, under whose authority he is assigned, as a collaborator in the service of God's people. As collaborators in ministry, serving alongside priests, deacons participate in the one apostolic ministry bestowed by Christ upon the Apostles and their successors. "The diaconate is not an abridged or substitute form of the priesthood; it is a full order in its own right."

In this Jubilee Year, we pray for deacons to do everything with humility, with joy without complaining, and in radical hospitality to the poor and marginalized. Allow the love of Jesus to flow from you, as you humbly serve others as missionary disciples. Listen with tender care and affection to the needs of others, especially the poor in your community. In this way, you will be messengers of hope to the world.

Give [them] eyes to see the needs of your people.

Give [them] peace of mind in obedience and service.

Grant [them] grace as [they] age so [they] may share your wisdom.
Make [their] heart[s] like yours so [they] may love your people. Amen.



Jubileo 2025: Jubileo de los Diáconos del 21 al 23 de Febrero



El Jubileo 2025 os invita a ser peregrinos de la esperanza. Para los cristianos, la esperanza está anclada en el encuentro con Jesús, cuya vida, muerte y resurrección revelan el amor transformador de Dios. Nuestra esperanza en Dios se renueva constantemente en el don del Espíritu Santo, el amor del Padre y del Hijo, que se da, también ahora, a la comunidad de los creyentes.

El diácono está obligado a dar prioridad a la vida espiritual y a vivir su diaconía con generosidad. Su modelo por excelencia es Jesucristo, el Siervo que vivió totalmente al servicio de su Padre para el bien de cada persona. Es necesario que cada diácono conozca intimamente a Cristo para vivir plenamente su ministerio, ya sea célibe o casado.



En su discurso de 2021 a los diáconos, el Papa Francisco expresó un mayor enfoque en cultivar la humildad y la generosidad en el ministerio. Dirigiéndose a ellos, el Santo Padre dice que espera diáconos humildes, dejando que todo el bien sea un secreto entre él y Dios; espera que los diáconos sean buenos esposos, padres y abuelos, que inspiren a los demás con su testimonio de alegría en todo, sin quejarse; espera que los diáconos sean centinelas, que conozcan el rostro de los pobres y también ayuden a los fieles cristianos a reconocer a Jesús en ellos.

El diácono ejerce su ministerio dentro de la comunión y misión de una Iglesia diocesana y en relación directa con su obispo diocesano, bajo cuya autoridad está asignado, como colaborador en el servicio del pueblo de Dios. Como colaboradores en el ministerio, sirviendo junto a los sacerdotes, los diáconos participan en el único ministerio apostólico otorgado por Cristo a los Apóstoles y sus sucesores. "El diaconado no es una forma abreviada o sustitutiva del sacerdocio; es una orden completa por derecho propio".

En este Año Jubilar, oramos para que los diáconos hagan todo con humildad, con alegría sin quejas y con hospitalidad radical hacia los pobres y marginados. Permitan que el amor de Jesús fluya de ustedes, mientras sirven humildemente a otros como discípulos misioneros. Escuche con tierno cuidado y afecto las necesidades de los demás, especialmente de los pobres de su comunidad. De esta manera seréis mensajeros de esperanza para el mundo. es de

Haz que [sus] corazones sean como el tuyo para que amen a tu pueblo. Amén.




